Hence it came about that the Word of God was humbly subject to Joseph, that He obeyed him, and that He rendered to him all those offices that children are bound to render to their parents. From this two-fold dignity flowed the obligation which nature lays upon the head of families, so that Joseph became the guardian, the administrator, and the legal defender of the divine house whose chief he was. And during the whole course of his life he fulfilled those charges and those duties."

Today his example speaks to us of how possible it is for us, too, to live our vocation, whatever it may be, in loving fidelity to the Word of God and in hope that looks forward to the fulfillment of God's promises as given to us in the scriptures and the teachings of the Church. St. Joseph knew the faithfulness of the Lord God and His eternal love for His people, and trusted in Him with his whole heart throughout his life.

In this Lenten Season and this Jubilee Year 2025, we ask St. Joseph to bless you and your families, and obtain many special graces for you in living your faith each day. In your kindness, we ask your help to continue to pay our monthly expenses and provide for our community. We are so thankful for your support, which makes possible our way of life in the Church.
